They are intended as a guide for the conduct of the sport and are in no way a guarantee against injury or death to a participant, spectator, or official.

The race director shall be empowered to permit reasonable and appropriate deviation from any of the specifications herein or impose any further restrictions that in his/her opinion does not alter the minimum acceptable requirements. NO EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED WARRANTY OF SAFETY SHALL RESULT FROM SUCH ALTERATION OF SPECIFICATIONS. Any interpretation or deviation of these rules is left to the discretion of the officials. Their decision is final

Anyone entering is subject to the following rules and regulations. All drivers must fill out an entry blank before

taking part. Officials reserve the right to accept or reject any and all applications. Only drivers,

owners and

mechanics who sign the release sheet will be permitted in the pit area.

DRIVERS ENTRY

Early Entry \$40.00 & day of event \$50.00 Entry fee for each car "No Refunds"

- 1. Driver must be at least 16 years of age and if under 18 years of age must have a notarized minor's release signed by a parent or guardian. Pit crew must be at least 15 years of age. Anyone under 18 must have notarized minors release completed.
- 2. All drivers must wear clean, long sleeved clothing.
- 3. Drivers and mechanics have an obligation to read the rules for their best interest. Drivers or pit crews not obeying these rules as well as all rules described at drivers' meeting prior to the Derby will be disqualified.
- 4. The conduct of drivers and/or crew can disqualify drivers from this and future events. There will be no finger gestures to anyone, fans or staff. There will be no arguing or fighting tolerated at all. If this happens you will be escorted off the fairgrounds, and car will become property of fair. You will be banned from the fairgrounds for all future events.
- 5. All cars must be removed from Fairground property **by 6:00 AM** Monday following the demo or they will become property of the Fair Association. Your cars are your responsibility, not the fair or demo personnel. If you leave it and something becomes missing, it's your fault.
- 6. One driver and one mechanic <u>per car</u> will be allowed in with the entry free.

7. Red flags and Horns mean to **Stop and do not move!** DQ will result if you move without being directed by an official.

All Cars must be built and deemed safe by Derby Inspectors. All cars must have a safety inspection sticker to compete.

INSURANCE

All injuries must be reported to officials, Sherriff's, or Emergency personnel at once!

SAFETY AND CAR SPECIFICATIONS - all exceptions to these rules will be considered illegal.

- 1. ALL CARS MUST BE STOCK NO MODIFICATIONS unless specified.
- 2. SAFETY AND CAR SPECIFICATIONS all exceptions to these rules will be considered illegal.
 - 3. All drivers must wear an approved DOT helmet. A full-face helmet including a chin wrap around is recommended (mandatory). **Drivers will be <u>disqualified</u>** if their helmet comes off. Safety belts are required and must be buckled. A quick release chest restraining shoulder harness such as in any automobile must be used.
 - 4. All glass, side windows, rear windows, including headlights, parking lights and plastic taillights must be removed.
 - 5. You must have working Brakes" Car must be able to stop by using brake pedal.
 - 6. Only the driver of the car will be allowed on the track at any time. No Exceptions! When the heat or feature is completed driver is to <u>stay with the car</u> unless removed by officials. If anyone else, crew, fan etc. is caught on the track they will be escorted off the grounds and the car will be disqualified.
 - 7. Only people with stage passes will be allowed on the stage unless you are a winner and you are coming to get your prize money and photos.
 - 8. IF YOU ARE ASKED TO LEAVE YOU WILL BE ESCORTED OUT BY THE SHERIFF, AND YOUR CAR WILL NOT BE RUN BY ANYONE ELSE. YOU WILL NOT BE REFUNDED.
 - 9. Must make **Contact** every **30** second.

10.If your car doesn't meet the rules stated it will not be able to compete.

All Cars will be inline and in specified heats upon completion of inspection or you will not compete

4cyl. 6cyl. / Minivan, mini trucks / V8 "Stock Rules":

STOCK ONLY

- Headers allowed
- Aftermarket shifter allowed
- Cages are recommended but not required. (Cage can't exceed past the back of the seat)
- No floating fuel cells
- Fuel cells inside of car only max 6 gal. Tank.
- Fuel cell must be in a metal enclosed box, and strapped securely. (No self-tappers)
- Harness swap allowed.
- Double tires allowed (DOT Only)
- Any compact OEM bumper 1990 and newer bolted 3/8' bolts max (No weld, No Slugs)
- Bumpers can't exceed wheelbase
- Hood/Trunk must be secured in 4 spots by chain or wire only!
- Doors / chain or wire only!
- Seat and lap belts required.
- No 4wd cars allowed / remove drive shaft
- Pre-bending is allowed
- Stock ride height / Stock suspension only (No Modified or solid stiff Suspension)
- NO WELDING WHATSOEVER
- Windshield bar required. (none on rear deck)
- 4cyl, 6cyl and V8 Stock will compete in feature together.
- V8 Cars must be <u>1980</u> and newer.
- <u>V8</u> Stock will follow these rules and have separate heats.
- Stock Mini vans will run with stock mini trucks in a feature.
- Must follow all required safety regulations.

Modified: 4cyl. 6cyl rules.

• Homemade or Aftermarket bumpers loaded / slugged allowed

- Bumpers <u>can't</u> exceed wheelbase. Wheelbase is determined by measuring center of the wheels.
- 4" point spread over 32" of bumper front
- Cages Recommended / minimum spreader bar required 3"x3"
- No exterior metal allowed / door, hoods, trunk patches only.
- Aftermarket or reinforced suspension allowed.
- Maximum ride height is 24" from the Ground to the top of Bumper
- Any tire allowed
- Cradles and mounts allowed
- No 4wd cars allowed.
- Must follow all required safety regulations.
- 4cyl. and 6cyl. Will compete in feature together.

"Stock" Truck & Van Full-size Rules

- Stock truck and large Vans
- No reinforcement or kickers
- Homemade or Aftermarket bumpers allowed / loaded / slugged ect.
- Bumpers can't exceed wheelbase
- No 4wd and No 4wd axel (DQ)
- Stock doubled tires only (DOT only)
- No lift kits, plow set ups, or hitches
- Headers allowed
- Floor shifter allowed
- Any wiring allowed
- Chain and wire 4 points, doors, trunks and hood.
- <u>PROTEST</u>: \$125.00 must accompany each <u>WRITTEN PROTEST</u> and must be submitted to the
 official Chief starter within <u>THREE MINUTES</u> of completion of the event. Protest must apply
 to winners only and
 - pertain to a Rule violation that, in the opinion of the officials, would give the car an advantage.
